GROUPS:

YMCA Camp Greenknoll's campers are placed in groups based on the grade they will be entering in the fall. There are a limited amount of campers in each group.

- Pre-K to grade 4 will be Co-ed.
- Pre-K to 2nd grade groups have a minimum ratio of 1 staff to 9 campers.
- 3rd grade and up groups have a ratio of 1 staff to 12 campers.

Co-ed offers campers the chance to interact as they would in the real world at various stages of childhood. This helps to create healthy social interaction between the genders and there is a better understanding of the opposite gender. Campers can then build a real-world relationship and much-needed social skills for future development. This interaction means that campers learn to relate to each other not as members of the opposite gender, but as humans. Campers learn to be more respectful towards each other, all in a respectful environment.

We're committed to providing an environment that promotes diversity, inclusion and community, a gender-blind environment for friendships at camp, and later in life. Through shared experience, open communication, trust, and respect, campers form solid bonds with other campers. And this makes for the best kind of friends!

COUNSELOR IN TRAINING

GOAL OF PROGRAM

YMCA Camp Greenknoll's Counselor in Training (CIT) Program focuses on developing strong leaders through discussion, observation, and supervised interaction with campers. This is a program for 14 and 15 year old's who are interested in working with children or just want to build their leadership skills while working in a team oriented environment.

The goal of YMCA Camp Greenknoll's Counselor-in-Training Program is to help young adults build leadership skills, learn the value of teamwork and exercise their decision making skills through activities and mentoring. Our Counselor-In-Training program combines the fun of camp with leadership and on-the-job training. The CIT program is a unique opportunity for motivated young adults to develop the necessary skills to be role models for children.

WHAT CITS CAN EXPECT

CITs spend part of their day enjoying a range of activities and part of their day learning about responsibility and professionalism by directly working with camp groups and assisting with activities.

CIT will receive Community Service hours for the time they spend volunteering in a group or time spent helping with a special activity at camp.
