The YMCA Camp Greenknoll Counselor-in-Training (CIT) Program provides 14- and 15-year-olds with the opportunity to build leadership and teamwork skills while gaining hands-on experience in childcare. Through a blend of discussions, observations, and supervised interactions, CIT participants learn responsibility and professionalism as they assist in camp activities.

Open to individuals aged 14 to 15, the CIT program emphasizes key areas such as leadership and job training, community service, and mentorship. CITs gain community service hours for their volunteer work, contributing by directly working with campers or supporting camp activities. Under the supervision of the CIT Coordinator, participants receive mentorship that fosters skill development, particularly in working with preschool and elementary-aged campers.

The CIT program equips participants with valuable experiences for future goals, such as college and careers, while creating lasting memories for campers. Benefits include personal growth in leadership, responsibility, and teamwork, practical experience in childcare, mentorship opportunities, and community service hours, all of which provide foundational skills for future endeavors.
